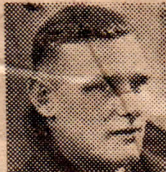

Corporal Joseph Russell, 713, General Construction Company, Royal Engineers. Sister: Mrs. C. Flanagan, 7, Berkshire-street, Newton, Manchester 10. Last heard of at Dunkirk.

Private Samuel Oliver, 2nd Battalion Manchester Regiment. Parents: 65, Egerton-street, Hulme, Manchester 15. Last heard of at Dunkirk.

Private Bernard Talbot, 4th Battalion Border Regiment. Fiancee: Miss Doris Lytton, Chorlton-street, Hr. Openshaw, Manchester. Last heard of from Northern France, between June 6 and 10.
